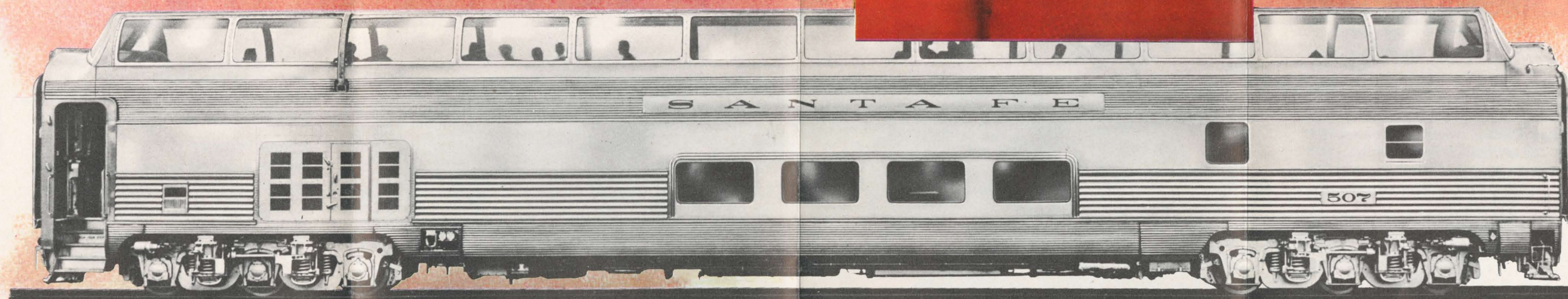


New "BIG DOME" LOUNGE CAR
