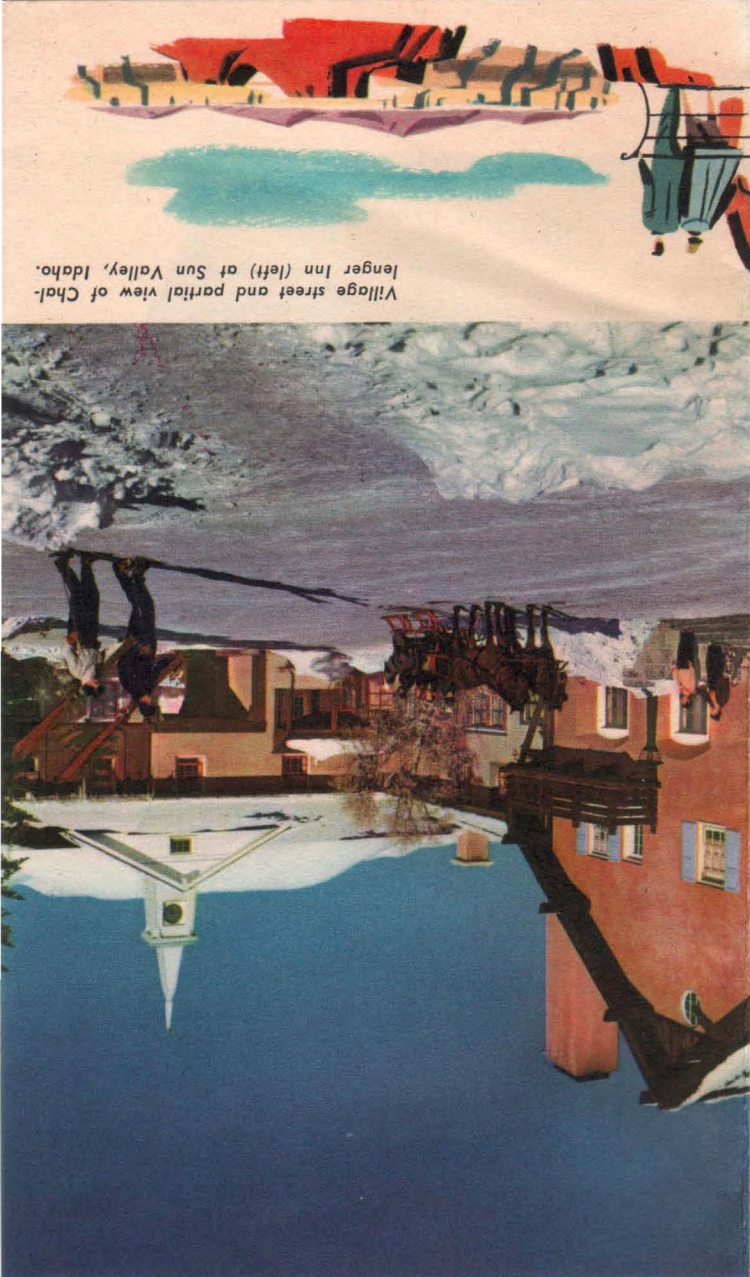




Village street and partial view of Chalonger Inn (left) at Sun Valley, Idaho.

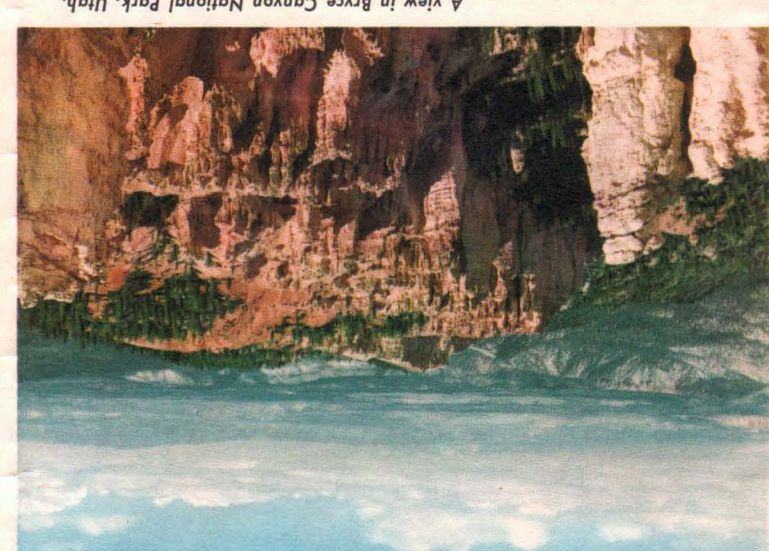

The Golden Gate Bridge spans San Francisco Bay.

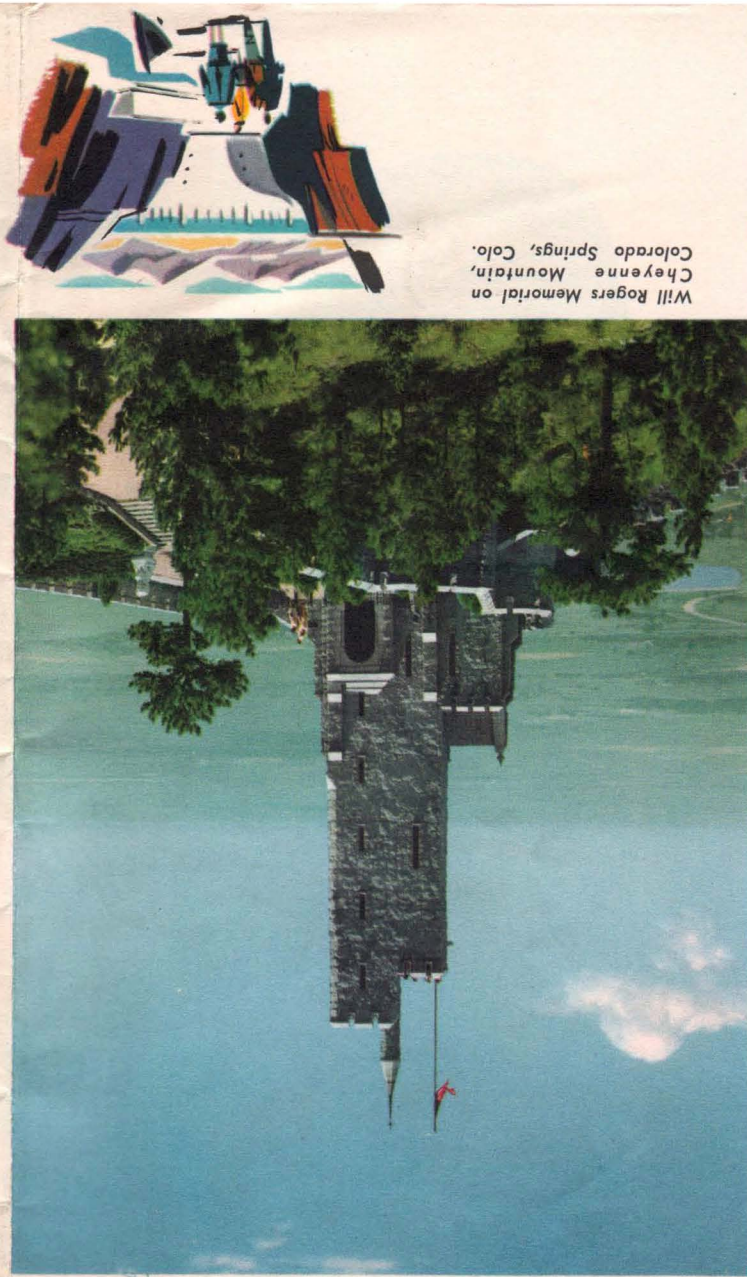

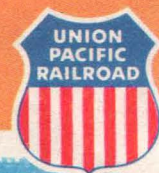

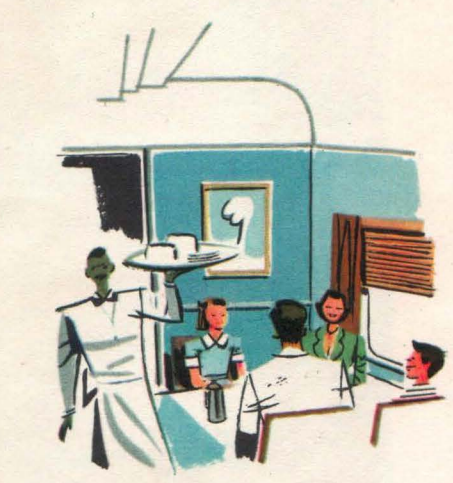
